NOC Request for medical equipment for Paraplegic Patients of the earthquake

Dear Mr. Wani,

I am pleased to announce that with the generous help of the Odstock Medical LTD of UK, we have acquired 18 units of MicroStim equipment. These equipments are Functional Electrical Stimulation (FES) tools that are used to successfully treating Paraplegic Patients with partial Spinal Chord Injuries. Presently Armed Forces Institute of Rehabilitation Medicine (AFIRM) has two such FES units. It is proposed to use 12 units to establish 3 FES centres in the 3 hospitals in RWP/ISD where most of the earthquake paraplegic patients are treated. Out of 18 FES Units 6 would be reserved for two paraplegic centres that will be established in the earthquake affected area in Kashmir and NWFP.

The equipment is send directly from UK by a courier service.


