PROGRAMMES

Our programmes for women and children are running well with increased enrolment:

- a. Women's literacy programme in collaboration with the Floral Arts Society and Dr. Fazlur Rehman Sethi of Peshawar University.
- b. Extra-curricular activities for school children e.g. painting, crafts, theatre and sports.

The classes are being conducted in two large tents, both have been 'summarized' with bamboo, matting and mud plaster and are quite cool. Women's literacy classes are held from 8 am to 12 noon. There are now over 60 women attending classes along with reading of the Holy Quran. 30 women have learnt to read 10 pages of the primer while 20 have learnt to read ayats from the Holy Quran. They were all given gifts of food packs etc.

There are now over 120 children attending the non-formal school in the afternoon. All children attending classes are provided with milk, a gift of Floral Arts Society. The gift of caps from ICI is extremely useful in the hot weather.

Sewing machines have been set up in one of the smaller tents that was 'summarized' earlier. Women who have registered are able to carry out stitching garments for their children and themselves. Unstitched cloth that has been received is also being provided to them. As we receive more machines, they will be placed in the large tent.

Our partner organization, the Floral Arts Society has set up literacy classes in Laramma camp, Peshawar. We are in the process of organizing construction of a base and 'summarization' of tent gifted by Lt. Col. Mian Liaquat Shah.

Two containers, courtesy of National Logistics Cell and Special Support Group, carrying food packs, hygiene kits, caps etc. provided by ICI Pakistan Ltd., 100 joras gifted by PTA, British Overseas School Karachi, and miscellaneous items collected at KPT Sports Complex, Karachi, arrived on 1 July '09 at the storage area provided courtesy of UET NWFP, Mardan Campus.

Our grateful thanks to all those engaged in facilitation, donation of goods and provision of funds. Assessment of requirements for each family is being made for distribution purposes in Sheikh Shahzad and Laramma Camps.
